Fixed Reimbursement Agreement

The undersigned applicant agrees to join Southeast Louisiana Firearms Safety, Inc. (SELFS, Inc.) as a "Fixed Reimbursement Member: under the terms described herein.

1. Range Officers receive a reimbursement payment for each shift worked at the range. This payment is to help offset incurred expenses. This STANDARD reimbursement consists of a mileage reimbursement based on Federal guidelines plus a *per diem* payment.
2. In the past, the cost of this STANDARD reimbursement has limited the number of Range Officers that SELFS, Inc. could accept.
3. To overcome this limit, SELFS, Inc. has established a FIXED REIMBURSEMENT RANGE OFFICER to allow more Range Officers to volunteer at the range.
4. As a FIXED REIMBURSEMENT RANGE OFFICER, the undersigned agrees to receive a reimbursement payment fixed at \$5.00 for each shift worked at the range as a Range Officer.
 - a. This FIXED REIMBURSEMENT will be *in lieu* of receiving the STANDARD reimbursement described in section 1 above.
 - b. Training shifts worked by an applicant do not qualify for reimbursement.
5. SELFS, Inc. has 80 STANDARD reimbursement Range Officer positions. This number is subject to change by a vote of the Board of Directors.
6. The number of FIXED REIMBURSEMENT RANGE OFFICERS is based on need and is set by the Board of Directors.
7. Whenever a vacancy occurs in the STANDARD reimbursement allotment, a FIXED REIMBURSEMENT RANGE OFFICER will fill it based on tenure (thereby changing that Range Officer from FIXED to STANDARD reimbursement).
8. FIXED REIMBURSEMENT RANGE OFFICERS may, on occasion, receive STANDARD reimbursement for shifts worked if the Board of Directors determines that it is financially feasible based on the fiscal plans and objectives of SELFS, Inc.
9. Other than the difference in the method of reimbursement, a FIXED REIMBURSEMENT RANGE OFFICER enjoys all of the rights, privileges, and obligations of a STANDARD REIMBURSEMENT RANGE OFFICER.
